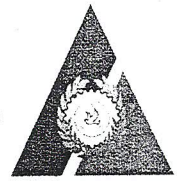

**“Requesting for Financial Assistance in the Conduct of the  
2018 RTIPC-Northern Mindanao Labor and Employment Summit”**

**WHEREAS**, the Regional Tripartite Industrial Peace Council-Northern Mindanao (RTIPC-NM) was established, with representatives from government, employers, workers and other special sectors, to serve as a continuing forum for tripartite advisement and consultation in encouraging reforms in government, empowering workers’ and employers’ organizations, enhancing their respective rights, attaining industrial peace, and improving productivity;

**WHEREAS**, the RTIPC-NM was revitalised through the appointment of the new set of council members by the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) Secretary Silvestre H. Bello III;

**WHEREAS**, the members of the RTIPC-NM as nominees the most representative workers’ and employers’ organisations and special sectors in the region took their oath of office before Bureau of Labor Relations (BLR) Director Benjo Santos M. Benavidez during the conduct of the 2017 Labor and Employment Summit held in Cagayan de Oro City on 17 December 2017;

**WHEREAS**, the RTIPC-NM took positive note of the successful conduct of the 2017 Labor and Employment Summit, particularly the learning sessions on rights and obligations of both workers and employers and updates on latest DOLE issuances;

**WHEREAS**, during the RTIPC-NM 1st Quarter meeting on February 14, 2018, the council members moved for the conduct an annual Labor and Employment Summit every December as a year-end culminating activity of the RTIPC-NM;

**WHEREAS**, the proposed 2018 Labor and Employment Summit shall gather the members of the RTIPC-NM, members of the region-wide Industry Tripartite Councils (ITCs) in the Academic and Agri-business Industries and existing ITCs in other sectors, as well as the members of the Local Government-Based TIPC for learning sessions, provision of updates on the latest labor and employment policies and issuances, and to foster harmonious relationship among the social partners in Northern Mindanao;

**WHEREAS**, the conduct of the proposed 2018 Labor and Employment Summit in Northern Mindanao would entail costs on materials, food, venue, accommodation and other necessary expenses related to the mounting of the said event.

**NOW THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, that we, the members of the Regional Tripartite Industrial Peace Council-Northern Mindanao, most respectfully REQUEST the BLR, through Director Benjo Santos M. Benavides, to assist the council in the conduct of the 2018 RTIPC-NM Labor and Employment Summit through provision of Financial Assistance in order to defray the expenses that will be incurred for the activity.
